Full Professor (W2) Church History

We are seeking qualified applicants for a professorship in the area of Church History. The professorship is located within the Institute of Catholic Theology at Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. The Institute is addressing societal challenges, which is why this professorship should not only perform research within a traditional area of church history, but also provide broader expertise in religious history.

The applicant is expected to take on a religious-historical perspective of the political impact of religion on modern day societies. The applicant will be expected to perform independent research and take on teaching responsibilities within the Bachelor and Master of Education in Catholic Religious Education; the Bachelor of Arts in Humanities and Social Sciences; the Master of Arts in Theology and Global Development.

Additional experience in the area of digital learning strategies are particularly welcome.

A Ph.D. degree is required; additionally, Habilitation (post-doctoral lecturing qualification), an exemplary record of research achievement as an assistant / an associate / a junior professor or university researcher and/or an outstanding career outside academia are highly desirable. Ability in and commitment to teaching are essential. The application should include supporting documents regarding success in teaching. German is not necessary to begin but will be expected as a teaching language within the first 5 years.
